As we observe the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, today we have the opportunity to reflect more thoroughly on the richness of the sacrament of the Eucharist as our spiritual nourishment.

Jesus is present in the Eucharist as a PERSON and as a FRIEND who loves us so dearly and wants to establish with us that perfect COMMUNION that is the essence of spiritual life on earth and of eternal life in heaven.



Here is an interesting story that illustrates the skepticism of an unbeliever with regards to the Eucharist and the tremendous wisdom that a believer draws from it.

A man came to a priest and wanted to make fun of his faith, so he asked, "How can bread and wine turn into the Body and Blood of Christ?" The priest answered, "No problem. You yourself change food into your body and blood, so why can't Christ do the same?"

But the objector did not give up. He asked, "But how can the entire Christ be in such a small host?" "In the same way that the vast landscape before you can fit into your little eye. "But he still persisted, "How can the same Christ be present in all your churches at the same time?"

The priest then took a mirror and let the man look into it. Then he let the mirror fall to the ground and broke it and said to the skeptic, "There is only one of you and yet you can find your face reflected in each piece of that broken mirror at the same time."

Let us repeat St. Thomas Aquinas' prayer of devotion in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament:

"O Sacrament most holy!
O Sacrament Divine!
All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine!"

The Columbarium at St. Aloysius/Our Lady Queen of Peace Cemetery

When we speak of the human body we always associate it with the human person. It is the human body that acts and is experienced by others. It is the body whose hands clothed the poor and embraced the sorrowing.

The body of a deceased Christian is also the body once washed in baptism, anointed with the oil of salvation, and fed with the Bread of Life. The Church's reverence for the sacredness of the human body grows out of a reverence and concern both natural and supernatural for the human person.

Sometimes it is not possible for the body to be present for the Funeral Liturgy. In extraordinary circumstances, cremation of a body is the only feasible choice. In keeping with a spirit of reverence, the cremated remains may be buried in a grave or entombed in a columbarium, that is, in a place especially designated for this purpose and reserved as such.

Our Catholic Cemetery, which is owned and operated by the Parishes of St. Aloysius and Our Lady Queen of Peace, on County Road 8, Fenelon Falls, (13 Bulmer Road), has now a placement in a niche structure called a "columbarium".


