



#### From the desk of the pastor...

When times are prosperous, lead us to thanksgiving and when times are troubled, lead us to a deepening trust in you.


All this in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

# BISHOP'S APPEAL INDIGENOUS RECONCILIATION FUND

The Bishop's Appeal for 2022 will take place on the weekends of July 2/3 and July 9/10, and it has been designated for the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund.

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has made a financial pledge of \$30 million dollars nationally and established the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund ("Fund"). Dioceses across Canada are joining this financial pledge and the Diocese of Peterborough will be contributing \$400,000.

The Fund will support Indigenous Peoples generated projects in these four areas:

- Healing and reconciliation for communities and families;
- Culture and language revitalization;
- Education and community building; and
- Dialogues for promoting indigenous spirituality and culture.
