



From the desk of the pastor...

Have you ever noticed how some people have the gift of hospitality? They are admirable. Others find it a bother, wishing like Mary that they could have the "better part."

Hospitality is work. If cleanliness is next to godliness, then hospitality is many steps closer. Hospitality is a virtue of our faith and it is an absolute necessity for our parishes if they would be vital and inviting places for God's kingdom to be built. Often the challenge for a parish to be welcoming is beyond its control. If they get too big, it's hard to know anyone, or feel in a real way that you belong. Still, the biggest cities are really just many small neighborhoods. If we would be hospitable, then small is a virtue.
