



From the desk of the pastor...

Melissa Anderson is an ambitious, go-getting woman whose main preoccupation is academic achievement. She has two undergraduate degrees, two MA degrees and a Ph.D. As she pursues her second Ph.D., the stress and strain of concentrated study begins to show.

She has lost her sense of humour. She has become more and more irritable. The frown on her face never seems to vanish. Finally, a wise old professor called her into his office. "Melissa" he said, "I see you're not at all relaxed, weighed down by MAs and Ph.Ds. It's plain and simple. You're killing yourself by degrees!"

The advice of that wise professor sounds like the concern of Jesus over His apostles in this 16th Sunday's gospel. After they were sent out in pairs, the apostles had returned and reported to Jesus all that they had done. They had been so busy, Mark tells us, that they had no time even to eat. (Mk 6:31).

They were, as that professor told Melissa, "Killing themselves by degrees." Not academic degrees of course! Jesus recognized the need to slow down, to back off for a while, to get away and take R and R (rest and recreation). He thus invited His disciples to "a lonely place by themselves, and rest a while" (Mk 6:30).

A successful businessman once asked the then Bishop Augustine for advice since he was doing well in business but felt that something was missing. Augustine's reply was: "You're running fast, but you're off-track!"

In "retreating," we are, as the Chinese proverb says, "making one step backward, but two steps forward."

The Greek philosopher Socrates knew the importance of self-reflection that's why he said: "An unreflected life is not worth living."

<u>Update to Lockdown</u> Measures



The Ontario provincial government announced that the province will be moving into Step 3 of the Reopening Strategy as of 12:01 a.m., Friday July 16, 2021.

In Step 3, there is no capacity limit for churches and missions. However, physical distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) is still required between parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household.

There is no need for contact tracing at the services in the church or mission unless there is a funeral. (See the section below for funerals.)

- Currently, face mask use indoors is mandatory for the celebrants and the faithful, even for those who are fully vaccinated.
- Congregational singing is not permitted in Step 3.
- A cantor or small choir may be utilized if singers/musicians are 3 metres from one another and any member of the congregation. Singers/musicians from the same household do not have to distance themselves from one another.
- One altar server or two or more altar servers from the same household are permitted at a Mass. Face masks must be worn, and physical distancing maintained.
- The celebrant's regular practice for greeting parishioners and processing at the beginning and the end of the liturgy may resume with adherence to the health precautions.

FUNERALS

For funerals in Step 3, the Bereavement Authority of Ontario has issued the following guidelines:

Indoor Funeral Services

Indoor funeral services are permitted with the physical distancing of two metres (six feet) between people.

Contact tracing information must be collected. Records must be kept for 30 days.

All attendees and staff must adhere to local public health unit restrictions.


