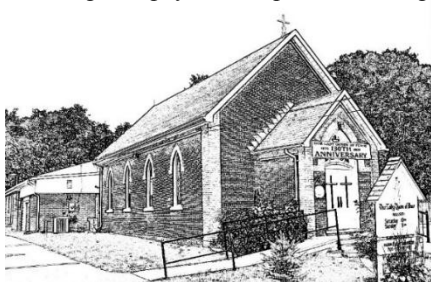

From the Desk of the Pastor...

How do we hear God's voice in a world that has so many different voices calling out to us? There is not just one way to experience God or to hear his voice. We can experience God and hear his voice in different ways.

One way we experience God is through Scripture. Each reading of the day is a great way to hear God's word and to reflect on the way it interacts with our own reality. The more we make it a habit to read and reflect upon God's word, the more we will hear him speak to us in his word. We can also experience God and hear his voice through the sacraments of the Church, through the Mass, and through the Eucharist. Even non-Catholics would attest that they have experienced God's presence in the Eucharist, Anointing of the Sick and other Sacraments in such a profound way that it motivated them to become Catholic. We can sometimes take God's voice and God's presence in the sacrament for granted and make the sacraments seem commonplace.

God can also be present in our trials, tribulations, and sorrows. A number of saints like St. Francis, St. Anthony and St. Pio, experienced the depths of sorrow and pain so profoundly that at times they would have welcomed death. Yet, they found God in their sorrows and their trials, and a faith that they had never known before. Our painful and challenging moments in life can either draw us closer to God or draw us away from God. We are called to find God accompanying us in those difficult moments.

Finally, we can find God and hear his voice in our good works done in faith and in the way we collaborate with God in our lives. We must see everything we do as a collaborative effort with God, impelled by the Holy Spirit working within us. None of it is done alone by our own efforts. In his first letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul states that we are God's co-workers.

Sometimes we are so intently looking for God in a dramatic act that we might miss the way He is there already speaking to us. May we open our hearts to the many ways God is there for us. May we open our eyes and ears to God's presence in our lives and the many ways that He speaks to us.
