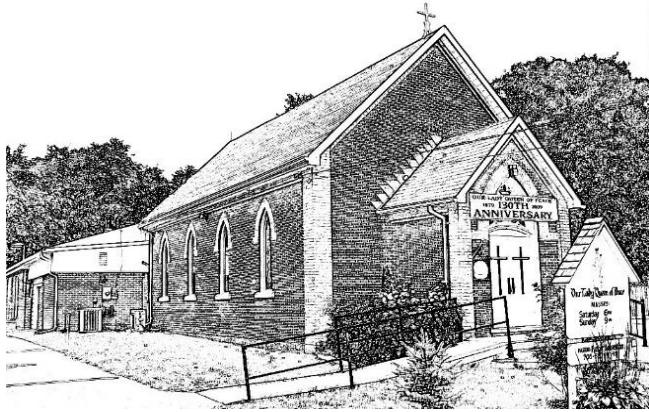

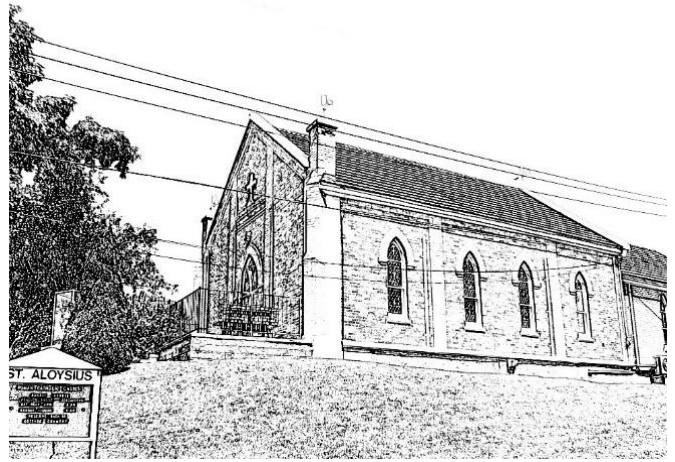

From the desk of the pastor...

Happy feast day of the Ascension to you all!

Jesus' departure and ascension into heaven was both an end and a beginning. It ended His physical presence, but it likewise marked a new beginning of Jesus' presence with His apostles and disciples in a new way.

Jesus promised that He would be with them always to the end of time. He assured them of His power – a power which overcame sin and death. Now as the glorified and risen Lord and Saviour ascended to the right hand of the Father in heaven, He also made clear to His followers that they wouldn't be doing it on their own. His very last words to His followers in Matthew's gospel were, "And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Mat 28:20b).

Jesus' parting words to His apostles point to the great mission which He also gives to all of us – to be witnesses of His saving death and His glorious resurrection. His ascension is a call for us to continually make Him present by allowing ourselves to become a living "Jesus" to other people. Our task is to proclaim God's gift of salvation, not only to the "people of Israel" but to "all the nations" – to our homes, offices, schools and work areas. Jesus intends God's love and gift of salvation for everyone – not just for a chosen few, but for all who are willing to accept God's words and be transformed by them.

All of us believers have been given a share in this task – to be heralds of the good news and ambassadors for Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world. We have not been left alone in this task, for we are part of that ongoing mystery of Jesus' presence in the world: The power of His Holy Spirit in us, with us and through us.
