



#### From the Desk of the Pastor...


It is hard to believe that a mustard seed, which appears almost like a tiny speck that can easily be blown away from the hand by the human breath, can grow big and become a nesting place for birds.

It is hard to believe, too, that a teaching began by an insignificant and underrated man from Nazareth has become a full-blown movement and community that spans all the continents and broke the immense barriers of race, culture and language, the seas and the oceans. When we go by sight alone, there are things that are simply hard to understand, let alone accept.

When it comes to big and small miracles of God wrought through the saints, we live by sight. What you see that defies logic leads you to somehow believe. It is easy to say yes to a higher power when, despite the clear prognosis of those who know better, a person suddenly gets healed and recovers fully his or her health. They do not see the why and the wherefore such miracles happened, but they believe.

In our times, we need to live more by faith. For we live in a faithless world. In this age of technology, where the rule is, if things could be done at all, then they should be done. For in this faithless world, everyone has the right to everything, including the right to die, never mind the wishes of a higher power who is Lord of life and death. Today, I invite you to look deeper into your own hearts. This is where eyesight does not count. In the arena of love and relationships, one does not need so much insight as heartsight. For it is only with the heart that one can see rightly and fully. One can know concepts, but only the heart can evaluate what the mind claims to see.

Today is a call to faith. And by faith we see why the mustard seed grows as it does. By faith, we get to understand why there is suffering and pain. By faith too, we see that suffering and pain are not the end-all and be-all of human existence. By faith, we see and understand, that despite all, there is a God who cares, a God who loves, and a God who makes the seed grow and mature and become, like the Church, a place to gather as one, and become one in God's love. We live by faith, not by sight.


