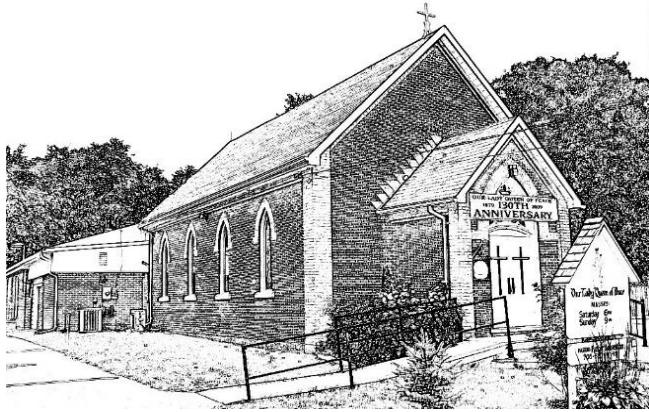

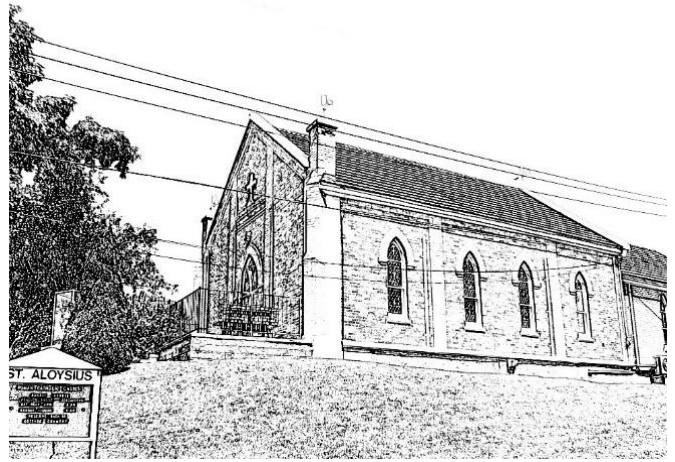

From the Desk of the Pastor...

There is a strong feel of **futility** running like a thread in the fabric of today's readings. Seemingly, that is . . . Ezekiel being forewarned about the rebellious Israelites to whom he is being sent to prophesy . . . described as "hard of face and obstinate of heart". . . St. Paul finding himself face to face with real suffering . . . "a thorn in the flesh," about which he beseeched the Lord "three times," to no avail . . . Jesus being confronted by his fellow town-mates with doubting and belittling questions, all pointing toward rejection and unbelief, from the very people who should have been the first to support him!

Futility! This seems to characterize the efforts of so many well-meaning people in our society! Despite heroic efforts at fostering the common good, despite the energies expended at making government really deliver the goods to the people that need them most, despite the repeated teachings of the Church on important matters of faith and morals, all we seem to see is the progressive degradation of societal norms, structures and values. Values taught in schools and proclaimed in pulpits do not stand a chance in the daily

life where just about the only real and substantial education that the young receive comes from social media. Prophets who risk rejection, continue to fight for the rights of the unborn, waging a seemingly lost battle for what is morally upright, whose light is now fast fading compared to the lustre and glitter of a consumerist, individualistic, hedonistic and throw-away culture of personal convenience and personal gain.

The list could go on. Shakespeare's words sound true enough for us: "the evil that men do lives after them; the good is oft interred with their bones." Our hearts thus find sympathetic resonance in the psalmist's prayer that we now make our very own: "Our eyes are fixed on the Lord, pleading for his mercy." (Responsorial Psalm)

**July 2024 Prayer Intentions: For pastoral care of the sick**

The Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network has released the list of prayer intentions set by Pope Francis for the year 2024. Each month, Pope Francis asks Catholics around the world to pray for a specific intention.

**“Let us pray that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick grant the Lord’s strength to those who receive it and to their loved ones, and that it may become for everyone an ever more visible sign of compassion and hope.” – Pope Francis**

The Pope is inviting the Church to pray for the pastoral care of the sick during the month of July 2024. In a recent video, he recalled that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not only for people at death’s doorstep. “If someone thinks that a priest offering the sacrament means that they are about to die”, said the Pope, “they have embraced a hopeless vision”. “Let us remember that the Anointing of the Sick is one of the ‘sacraments of healing,’ of ‘restoration,’ that heals the spirit,” said the Pope. He added that the sacrament is always available for people who are ill, especially the elderly.

“When a person is very ill,” he said, “it’s advisable to give them the Anointing of the Sick.” Pope Francis concluded by praying that the sacrament may become a more visible sign of compassion and hope.
