



#### From the desk of the pastor...

Somebody once said that our experience of the Holy Spirit is like wearing eyeglasses. When they are set comfortably on our nose, we are not aware of them. Their best work is done when, through them, we can see a movie we are watching. Glasses are not to be seen, but to be seen through.

The Holy Spirit is like that. To complain that we cannot find Him is like complaining we can't find our glasses when all the while we are wearing them.

The Feast of PENTECOST commemorates that momentous event when the Holy Spirit descended on the timid apostles at the Upper Room.

One symbol which tells us something about the mysterious work of the Holy Spirit is a mighty wind and tongues of fire descending over the apostles' heads. From its name, the Spirit "inspires" or "breathes life into" as in mouth-to-mouth resuscitation. One who is "inspired" receives life or becomes invigorated. Don't we often say, "This person inspires me"?

The Spirit is the Church's breath. The divine breath gave the young Christian Church astonishing powers.

The Spirit also moves us to conversion or spiritual renewal. When one experiences remorse for sin, the Spirit renews that person giving him new life.

Did you ever feel turning a new life because of guilt feelings over some illegal deals or illicit relationships? Or were you inspired to do good to people because of the life of a particular saint you read?

Such are the promptings of the Holy Spirit. But the question is: Do you heed the Spirit's promptings? The Spirit keeps calling us but we must heed His call if we want to be transformed.

# Update to Lockdown Measures



Below is the Information from the Bishop concerning new restrictions announced Friday April 16<sup>th</sup> for the Province of Ontario.

## PETERBOROUGH, CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN DEANERIES

Effective Monday, April 19, 2021, priests may celebrate weekday Mass for a maximum of 10 people including the celebrant and liturgical ministers if the pastor deems it safe and feasible.

There is to be no public celebration of the Sunday but Mass may be celebrated for the purpose of livestreaming with adherence to the capacity limit of ten (including the celebrant, technicians, and liturgical ministers).

- **OTHER LITURGICAL RITES:** Baptisms, weddings and funerals may proceed observing the capacity limit of 10 people.
- **HEALTH PRECAUTIONS:** All health precautions must be observed including the requirement to maintain contact tracing records.
- STAY WITHIN YOUR REGION. Travel outside of the jurisdiction must be curtailed unless absolutely necessary.
- VACCINATION Encourage parishioners to read the materials about the COVID-19 vaccination and to get vaccinated when they are eligible. https://www.peterboroughdiocese.org/en/how-do-i-


