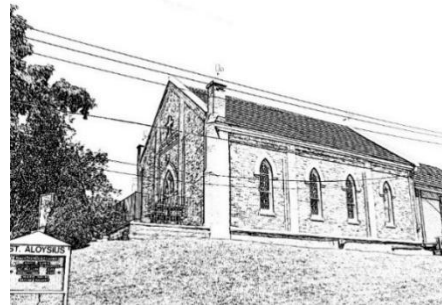

From the Desk of the Pastor...

I have a question for you. Who is Jesus – for you? We need to answer this by professing what we know of, or about, Jesus. We are given today by our readings from the Scriptures, some of the titles and phrases that are associated with Him : Son of Man, Son of God, the Christ, Lamb of God, Lord, Immanuel/Emmanuel, the One Who Saves, the Way, the Truth, the Life, the Light of the World, the Good Shepherd, Prince of Peace, King of kings, etc., Yet even after we mention some of His titles and names, the more important questions are: Who is Jesus for you? That implies a relationship that you have with Him. When you think about Jesus, and more importantly, when you pray (relate) to Him, how do you address Him and what images of Him do you have?

One title and image of Jesus that we have is the Lamb of God. John in our Gospel points out Jesus as the Lamb of God. A spotless lamb was used in sacrifices of old in the Old Testament. The blood of the lamb was used by the Israelites to mark the doorposts of their homes at the time of the Exodus. When the “angel of death” saw the blood of the lamb on the door, the angel “passed over” the home, for it was the home of a believer. Moses and Aaron later blessed the Holy of Holies and the people with the blood of a lamb. Thus, the blood of the lamb signified that the people were holy people – God’s people, their holiness not coming from who they were or what they did, but from God and what God had done, is doing, and will continue to do. This image continued in the New Testament. It is no coincidence that Jesus was killed on the day of Passover when the blood of the paschal lamb was shed in the Temple in Jerusalem. Thus, St. John the Baptist points out Jesus as the Lamb of God Who takes away the sins of the world. Jesus is the true sacrificial Lamb Whose Blood brings salvation to those marked with His blood.

All these titles cause us to reflect on who Jesus is for us and on our relationship with Him. We realize that Jesus is God with human flesh, Who has come to fulfill the promises of old and bring about the new Reign of God on earth. He has saved us and all people from their sinfulness and brought us freedom as children of God through His death and resurrection.

How about you? How do you relate to our Lord? Which image or title speaks most clearly of your relationship with Jesus in prayer right now? Does it shape as well your relationship with other people every day? Or do you come here today to know Jesus more and echo the same words of the Psalmist, “Here I am Lord; I come to do your will!”?

May you have a blessed Sunday and week ahead everyone!
