

### From the Desk of the Pastor...

So important is the emergence of John the Baptizer in human history that Luke dates his appearance in six different ways. In his Gospel, Luke introduces John as prophets were introduced in the First Testament ("the word of God was spoken to John son of Zechariah in the desert"). As does Matthew and Mark, Luke cites the famous passage from Isaiah regarding "a herald's voice in the desert" to describe the Baptizer's mission – but Luke quotes more of the Isaiah prophecy than his synoptic counterparts, including the promise of universal salvation that is so central to Luke's Gospel.

Forms of "baptism" were common in the Judaism of Gospel times: in some Jewish communities, it was through baptism rather than circumcision that a Gentile became a Jew. But John's baptism was distinctive. His baptism at the Jordan was a rite of repentance and *metanoia* – a conversion of heart and spirit. The Baptizer's ministry fulfilled the promise of Ezekiel (Ezekiel 36: 25-26): that, at the dawn of a new age, the God of Israel would purify his people from their sins with clean water and instill in them a new heart and spirit.



#### Second Sunday of Advent: Faith

The second Sunday of Advent in 2024 will be Sunday, December 8th. After a chaotic year, there is comfort to be found when we pause to read, pray and reflect over the course of the Advent season...a time when believers eagerly anticipate the celebration of Christ's birth.

The second Sunday of Advent gives us the opportunity to **prepare our hearts in faithful waiting**, celebrate the birth of Jesus and ready ourselves for his second coming. It's a beautiful chance to reflect on the ways prophecy has been fulfilled and to ponder what the future (promised to us through prophecies) will bring.

During this second week of Advent, we pause to remember who God is and what He has done for us. When our lives are hurried, we only have the chance to focus on our to-do lists. Making space in our schedules for <u>prayer</u> and meditation helps us to better see God at work in our lives and in our world.

The tradition for the second Sunday of Advent includes lighting the second purple candle that is a symbol of faith.

This second Sunday of Advent we read, pray and reflect on the hope God's plan gives us (foretold by the prophets and fulfilled by the life and death of Christ) and we meditate on the promise of Christ's coming glory-filled return.


