From the desk of the pastor...

EVERYBODY wants to be happy. But happiness is a very elusive thing. Some maintain that you can be happy if you have lots of money. Others believe in the saying “Live with gusto or to the fullest; you live life only once.”

When Christ came, he had a blueprint or guideline for living which turned upside down the prescriptions for happiness the world offers. That prescription is contained in this 6th Sunday's gospel on “Beatitudes” (Be Happy Attitudes) according to St. Luke (6:28-38).

Jesus declares “Happy are you who are poor, for the kingdom of God is yours.” Our Lord never intended to approve of the grinding poverty that we see in the slums of our societies. It's this kind of thing that every Christian should try to eradicate from his midst.

The rich are considered “poor” if they have the spirit of detachment from their wealth or don't forget God as the source of their blessings and can reach out to their destitute brethren.

In pursuit of the “good things” in life, some have forgotten their eternal destiny of heaven and have made money their god. So much that some people have to steal, cheat and kill in pursuit of having more money and more of it. Jesus reminds us: “Store up treasures in heaven where neither rust nor moth can destroy” (Matt 6:20).

Remember, too, St. Augustine who, after a life lived in worldly pleasures, said in the end: “Lord, our hearts are made for You. Our hearts are restless until they rest in You.”

COVID-19 UPDATE

In the Diocese of Peterborough, Most Reverend Bishop Miehme has provided these guidelines for the implementation of the health precautions:

- Households attending the church must maintain a physical distance of 6 feet or 2 metres between each other. Attendance at the church is limited to fifty percent of the church's posted capacity.
- The clergy and the faithful must wear a face mask in the church.
- **Congregational singing is strongly discouraged at this time.**
- The processional and recessional will take place respectively from the sacristy to the sanctuary and from the sanctuary to the sacristy to avoid gatherings at the church doors.
- Parish Halls are closed for the time being. The exception to this closure is AA meetings, Food Banks and other designated entities.
- The Diocesan and Parish Staff are working remotely as much as possible.

It is hoped that these new measures will curtail or significantly mitigate the current surge of the Omicron variant and the COVID-19 virus.
