From the desk of the pastor...

What wonderful news that all parishes and missions are open for Ash Wednesday at 30% capacity and Daily Mass and Sunday Mass as well! Of course, we have observed all pandemic health precautions that have been put in place.

Welcome to the Season of Lent! Okay, "What can I do for Lent?" is a million-dollar question. One might say: "I'll give up smoking." Sometimes this becomes more of a sacrifice for those we live with than for ourselves. Others say: "I'll give up candy." Here we start by imitating a squirrel storing nuts for winter. When Easter arrives, we partake of our savings of candy and make up for lost time. "I'll pray an extra hour each day." What good is that if I can't make it through my workday because I'm so tired from lack of sleep?

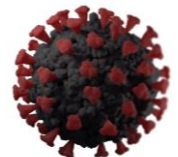

**Update to
Lockdown Measures**



As of 12:01 a.m. on Tuesday, February 16, the Diocese of Peterborough will transition to the colour-coded Framework, and the limit of 30% for churches will apply. Each of the 5 regional Health Units serving the Diocese (Peterborough, Durham, HKPR, Simcoe-Muskoka, and North Bay-Parry Sound) will designate whether the jurisdiction is grey, red, orange, yellow, or green. Daily Mass and Sunday Mass at 30% capacity observing all other pandemic health precautions will resume at all parishes and missions on Tuesday, February 16th.

All parishes and missions are open for Ash Wednesday at 30% capacity observing all pandemic health precautions that have been put in place.
