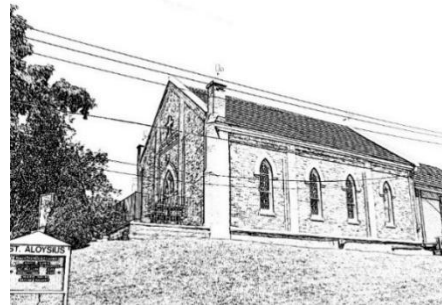

From the Desk of the Pastor...

How would you react when you are confronted with the reality of the end times? You could be fearful by the apparent message of doom and gloom in Sunday's readings. What is even more important than the fact that the end is coming? What is more important is what you do with the time we have until the end. The message of the Lord Jesus is one of encouragement, hope and even excitement. If you have accepted the Good News of salvation and patterned your life on living the Gospel, then you are reassured that the end of your existence on this earth (though possibly painful) is not the ultimate destiny and end of your life. GOD has promised an eternal life of healing, wholeness and salvation for those who respond faithfully to God.

Every day our Lord invites you to prepare yourself and others to lead a life according to His will. Do you consider His invitation? Have you decided which way you are heading? You may have experienced people who seem completely set on going to heaven. Their actions and speech demonstrate that they are on their way to enjoying the fullness of heaven. It is great to be around them. They radiate joy and peace beyond the ordinary. You may have, on the other hand, encountered individuals who are dead set on going to hell, and they want to drag as many other people as possible along with them. Being around such people drains you of energy and enthusiasm.

The choice is yours. You can accept what God has promised, and you can live a life faithful to the Lord Jesus Who loves you, or you can reject all that He offers and spend eternity without God. God, the eternal and just judge, carries out the sentence that you have chosen for yourself. To accept what GOD offers means you must work at living it out in your life. That is part of what Paul urges the Thessalonians to do. They must work in their faith. They must not be busybodies who sit around and criticize others. They must do their fair share in spreading the faith, for the Lord Jesus is coming, but may not be here immediately.

Does your life demonstrate that you are working and living for the Lord Jesus? You must make the choice, and your life must, and will (now and forever), reflect the choice you make. Heaven is how you decide and live it today. And with hope, the Lord Jesus who lived, ministered, died and rose in order that you will be welcomed into His Eternal Presence, will confirm your choice when you are judged not only at the moment of your death, but also at the end of time when your choice will be evident to all.

"Now choose life so that you and your children may live." (Deuteronomy 13:19)
