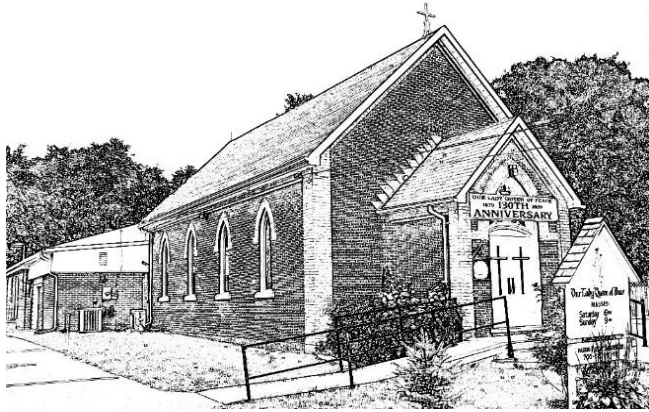

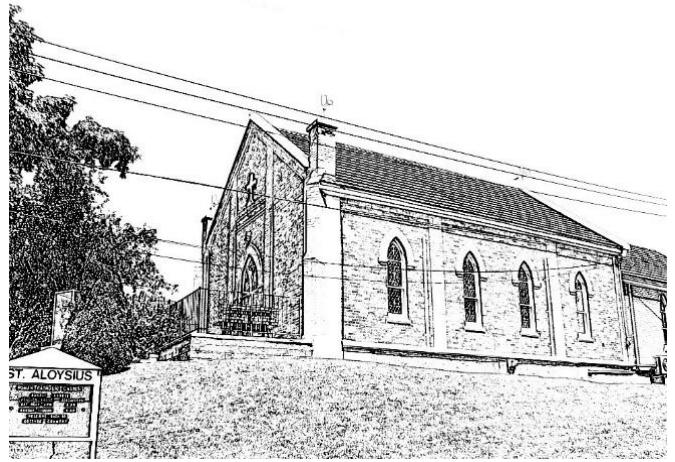

From the Desk of the Pastor...



On this 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Word of God is inviting us to reflect on certain facts which are true and for sure will happen to us. All three readings are speaking of the basic and the fundamental results of our earthly existence. What will happen to the world? What will happen to us after this earthly life? And what is the outcome of our earthly existence?

We are continually reminded of the uncertainty of this earthly life and the certainty of the heavenly life. Our life on earth is temporal and the life to come is permanent. The fundamental truth of our earthly life is that we are here on earth to prepare ourselves to live permanently in the heavenly life. It is our duty to accept that we are not for this world but we are here to prepare our life for the next world to come. God is continually speaking to us and reminding us to be prepared and to be ready always to live a life that is permanent for all ages.

The bible is speaking about the judgment of God in many places. As we see in today's first reading **Michael, the great prince, will gather the whole nations together for judgment of God.** In the same way, in the New Testament, Jesus is also reminding the people with the same concept of the last judgment.

The Lord will ask us 6 questions and our response should be "YES" to all

1. I was hungry, and did you give me anything to eat?
2. I was thirsty, and did you give me anything to drink?
3. I was a stranger, and did you welcome me?
4. I was naked, and did you give me clothing?
5. I was sick, and did you take care of me?
6. I was in prison, and did you visit me?

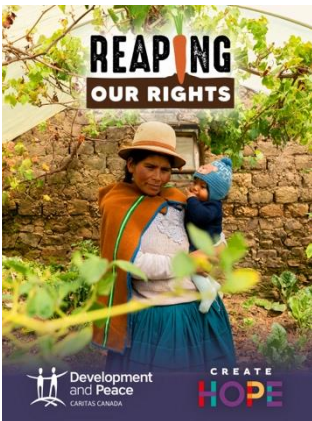

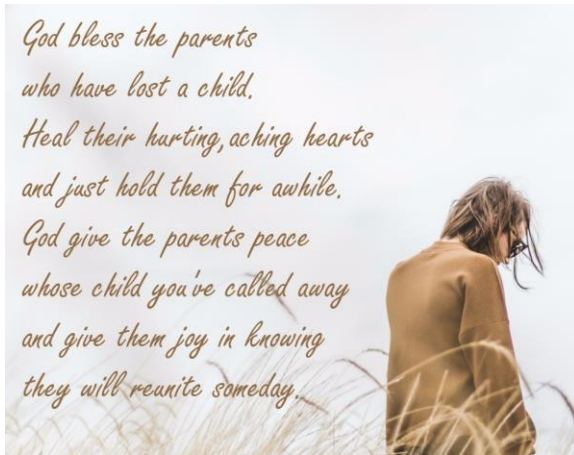
