



From the Desk of the Pastor...

Mark says the man who approached Jesus was a young rich man.

Mark narrates the way he approaches Jesus: He comes running and kneels before Jesus. The Gospel presents two other characters who also behave like this man. One was the demoniac, who was possessed with an evil spirit. The other was the leper, who felt impure and punished by God. This young and rich man behaves as if he is possessed, and that makes him feel impure, like a leper.

He is indeed possessed by the most dangerous of demons: the demon that forces him to cling to the goods of this world. It is the devil that makes him attach his heart to the riches of the world. But who doesn't love to be rich and enjoy the comforts of life?

But, the greed of riches will make you lose the meaning of life. This man runs up to Jesus for something that only Jesus could give: peace of mind and harmony in his life. Jesus proposes him a new approach to his life. He says: 'You must share your assets. They are not yours, they belong to God and you must share them with those who need them.' Give up, abandon, part with — are the words we must pay attention to. The rich young man moves away sad.

Jesus is clear: One does not enter into the new world that he proposes unless one accepts the logic of sharing the goods with all. Goods of this world must be transformed into love. "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle...." It cannot happen, even if it tries. But then comes the promise: "For people it is impossible, but not for God because for God everything is possible." When we allow the proposal of Jesus to penetrate our hearts, human nature is restored in our lives and the demon of material possessions and riches is driven out of our lives. Once that leprosy of selfishness is healed from our body, we become joyful to make ourself available to our brothers and sisters.

REMEMBERING THE POOR SOULS DURING NOVEMBER AND YEAR-ROUND

During the month of November, the Church invites us to remember the holy souls in purgatory. But after receiving the <u>indulgences</u> this month offers, we often forget these poor souls throughout the rest of the year.

However, regularly practicing this Spiritual Work of Mercy of praying for the dead not only benefits the holy souls but the Church as a whole.

The Church extends far beyond its visible members on earth. Membership in the mystical Body of Christ actually exists in three "states."

Those of us on earth are members of the Church Militant, <u>pilgrims</u> fighting for holiness against the darkness of this world. Then of course, we have the <u>Church Triumphant</u>, who have won the battle and now enjoy the fullness of heaven.

The Church Suffering or the Church Penitent consists of those in purgatory who died in the friendship of God but still needed cleansing of the temporal effects of sin. They aren't quite ready to go straight into the arms of God the moment of their death!

The holy souls of the deceased or those living eternally in Christ's light are as much our brothers and sisters as the people sitting next to you in the pews on Sunday. When one part of the body suffers, "all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy" (1 Cor 12:26).

The souls in purgatory can no longer help or merit anything for themselves; they have no more opportunities for <u>penances</u> and good works to atone for their sins. And, much like here on Earth, the process of being separated from sin will prove challenging and painful.

Purgatory, while a temporary stop for souls bound for glory and a testament to God's mercy and love, is <u>a kind of suffering</u>. But God doesn't make these souls go through this difficult process alone. Our prayers and sacrifices can help them finally and fully enter into the presence of God.

Here are some ways you can help these dear suffering friends during the month of November and throughout the year:

Follow the Holy Spirit's lead. Do you ever find yourself thinking about a family member, friend or even acquaintance who has passed as you go about your day?

Consider that an invitation to pray for that person.

Have a Mass said for a loved one. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the most efficacious way to ease the suffering of the souls in purgatory. You can request to have Masses said for specific people. You can use it as a way to remember someone on their birthday or on the anniversary of their death.

Spiritually adopt a soul. Many people, including many Catholics, don't recognize the importance of praying for the dying and the deceased. Many souls die alone and suffer alone without the help from their family and friends on earth. But they don't have to.Adopt an unknown, dying soul or pray for a soul forgotten in purgatory with no one to pray for them. Yes, pray a Rosary for them each day.


