

From the Desk of the Pastor...

We commit sins in two ways, either by Commission or Omission. Our Catholic faith teaches that not doing what one is supposed to do is a sin of Omission, while doing what is forbidden is a sin of Commission. In the Parable of Lazarus and the Rich Man in today's Gospel, the rich man was punished by God because he continued to commit the sin of Omission, unresponsive to misery around him, although he drove neither the poor beggar nor the stray dogs from in front of his door and did not prevent either from sharing the discarded crumbs and leftovers from his table. He was not cruel to Lazarus. The sin of the rich man was that he never noticed Lazarus as a human being and a brother. He led a life of luxury and self-indulgence, totally ignoring the poor people around him. Lazarus represents a fact of life: the poor, the sick and the unfortunate who are always around us. The rich man did no wrong, but he did nothing good, either.

It is not wrong to be rich, but it is wrong not to share our blessings with our less fortunate brothers and sisters. If we are greatly blessed with much by way of comfort and enjoyed a life of luxury, as followers of the Lord our response should be pure gratefulness by sharing our blessings to others especially the needy and not serious social blindness and insensitivity to both the needs of the poor and suffering around us and to genuine justice.

This same attitude of the rich man seems to be endemic today. Almost half of the world population today is homeless and has nothing to eat. Why does this happen? It happens because of the sins of omission of those people who selfishly continue to be blind and insensitive to the many Lazarus out there.

St. Augustine reminds us, "What does love look like? It has the hands to help others. It has the feet to hasten to the poor and needy. It has eyes to see misery and want. It has the ears to hear the sighs and sorrows of men. That is what love looks like." Indeed, something to think about as followers of Jesus.


