



## From the Desk of the Pastor...

The exhortations of this Sunday's readings are directed to all of us as a reminder of our primordial calling, being disciples of Jesus. And discipleship is a call to rise above our normal human way of acting. We cannot rise to this higher level of acting by our own doing. We can only do this with God's help, focusing on the life and ministry of our Lord, and with the guidance and empowerment of the Holy Spirit.

An example of one acting on this higher level is what Paul asks of Philemon in the second reading. Philemon has every right to not only have his slave (Onesimus) back, but to harshly punish him for his running away. Paul is asking Philemon not to continue the acceptable practice of his time of dominating his slave, but to treat the once useless slave as a useful brother and co-worker in the Lord Jesus and in proclaiming the Good News. For Philemon to do as Paul suggests will take an extraordinary amount of strength and commitment, and the help of God.

In a similar manner, Jesus is asking us, His disciples today, to rise above our normal way of relating to family, possessions and living in general. We must be completely dedicated to the life and mission of Jesus.

As we view discipleship, we are reminded of the relationship that existed between apprentices and master-craftsperson in ages past. When a young person wanted to learn a trade, he would go to a master craftpersons not only to give him books or lectures. The disciple of the master would live with the artist, day in and day out. The apprentice would learn not just his craft but would take on the whole attitude and personality of the master. The individuality of the disciple would dissolve as he would immerse himself with the whole attitude and activity of the master. The student would have to put his whole mind, soul, strength and actions into becoming like his master-teacher. And after years of working under the master, the highest compliment that he would receive is for someone to say, "I don't know who you are, but I know who your master is because your work is perfectly patterned on your master."

What we need to do as disciples is to let go of our own prejudices and selfish ways and imitate our Lord. We must apply ourselves fully to the work of the Jesus, consciously giving our all. Calling upon the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we must renounce anything that prevents us from fully following the Master. And hopefully, someday, someone will say to us, "I am not too sure of who you are, but I know who is your Master-Teacher, for your life and work is a reflection of Jesus."
